Governor Abbott, Texas National Guard COVID-19 Mobile Specimen Collection Site - Wharton County

Citizens in the Wharton County can now register for a COVID-19 mobile specimen collection appointment. The mobile specimen collection site is a joint collaboration, operated by DSHS (Texas Department of State Health Services), TDEM (Texas Division of Emergency Management), TMD (Texas Military Department), TX EMTF (Texas Emergency Medical Task Force) and The RACs (HIPP Providers). There is no charge for specimen collection and processing.

To be eligible for mobile specimen collection, you must have one or more symptoms of COVID-19.

Symptoms include:

- Fever and/or Chills
- Fatigue
- Shortness of Breath
- Headaches
- Nasal Congestion

- Loss of Taste and/or Smell
- Cough (Dry or Productive)
- Body aches/muscle or joint pain
- Sore Throat
- Nausea / Vomiting / Diarrhea
