Wharton County, TX, Monday, November 30, 2020 1000 hours

Last Wednesday evening, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have eighteen (18) new positive cases of COVID-19, and no (0) recoveries. We have also, sadly, received a report of five (5) more deaths, thus the number of fatalities is now fifty-six (56.) Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at one-hundred thirty-four (134), that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be tomorrow, Tuesday, DECEMBER 1, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. The test is free.
