Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have seventy-one (71) new positive cases of COVID-19, and **fifty-five** (55) recoveries. The number of fatalities remains at **fifty-six** (56.) Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **one-hundred sixty-nine** (169), that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be TODAY, Tuesday, DECEMBER 1, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. The test is free.
