Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **eleven (11)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **seventeen (17)** recoveries. The number of fatalities remains at **fifty-six (56.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **one-hundred seventy-six (176)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next, Tuesday, DECEMBER 8, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. The test is free.
