Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **seventy-one (71)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **fifty-nine (59)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **fifty-six (56.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **one-hundred eighty-six (188)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next, Tuesday, DECEMBER 15, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. We will post the link as soon as it is published. The test is free.
