## Wharton County, TX, Friday, December 11, 2020 1100 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **twenty-five (25)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **thirty-one (31)** recoveries. We have been notified of **three (3)** additional deaths, therefore the number of confirmed fatalities is now **fifty-nine (59.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred two (202)**, that does NOT include any probables.
