Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred four** (104) new positive cases of COVID-19, and **seventy-nine** (79) recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-three** (63.) Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred six** (206), that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next, Tuesday, DECEMBER 22, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening The test is free. This may be the final opportunity for 2020.
