Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **sixty-one (61)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **sixty-three (63)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-three (63.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred thirty-nine (239)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next, Tuesday, DECEMBER 22, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening The test is free.
