## Wharton County, TX, Monday, December 21, 2020 1100 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **twenty (20)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **eighteen (18)** recoveries. We have also received a report of **four (4)** additional death, bringing the number of confirmed fatalities to **sixty-seven (67.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred forty-two (242)**, that does NOT include any probables.
