## Wharton County, TX, Wednesday, December 23, 2020 1100 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **ninety-five (95)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **seventy-seven (77)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-seven (67)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred sixty-five (265)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, DECEMBER 29, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is <u>https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening</u> The test is free.
