Wharton County, TX, Tuesday, December 29, 2020 1000 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred twenty-three (123)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **one hundred forty-one (141)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-seven (67)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred eighty-six (286)**, that does NOT include any probables. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **15.17%**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be TODAY, DECEMBER 29, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening The test is free.
