## Wharton County, TX, Thursday, December 31, 2020 1000 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **forty (40)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **twenty-six (26)** recoveries. The number of confirmed fatalities remains at **sixty-seven (67)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **two hundred fifty-seven (257)**, that does NOT include any probables. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **15.48%**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, January 5, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is <u>https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening</u> The test is free.
