## Wharton County, TX, Monday, November 2, 2020 0900 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **twenty-five (25)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **no (0)** recoveries. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalites, thus our total number of COVID-19 confirmed deaths remains at **forty-nine (49)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **fifty-one (51)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 6, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 am - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. This is a free test.
