Over the past week, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **seventy-six (76)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **thirty-five (35)** recoveries. The total number of fatalities remains at **forty-nine (49.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **eighty-nine (89)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, NOVEMBER 24, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. The test is free.
