Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **thirteen (13)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **thirteen (13)** recoveries. We are also recording an adjustment to Monday's numbers – our local DSHS office has once again informed us that there was a glitch in the Texas Health Trace system which caused 22 cases to be added in error. The total number of fatalities remains at **forty-nine (49.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **forty (40)**, that does NOT include any probables.
