## Wharton County, TX Tuesday, May 25, 2021 1000 hours

**For the period of May 19-May 25**, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **thirty-six (36)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **forty-one (41)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **4.34%**.

IMPORTANT: COVID-19 testing is being conducted tomorrow, WEDNESDAY, MAY 26, at the WHARTON CIVIC CENTER, from 8 am – 4 pm. *The link is <u>https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening</u> or you can text DOCSTX to 41411. The test is free. Vaccination clinics are still being held – today at East Bernard, tomorrow at Boling & in Wharton at Oakbend Hospital. You must register for the Oakbend clinic at oakbendmedcenter.org.*
