## Wharton County, TX, Tuesday, April 20, 2021 0900 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **thirty-six (36)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **twenty (20)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **6.74%**.

IMPORTANT: COVID-19 testing is being done TODAY, TUESDAY, APRIL 20, at the EL CAMPO CIVIC CENTER, from 8 am – 4 pm.
