Over the past week, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **thirty-one (31)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **twenty-six (6)** recoveries, and **two (2)** adjustments. The total number of fatalities remains at **forty-nine (49.)** Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **fifty-three (53)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: *County-wide testing will be next Tuesday, NOVEMBER 17, at the El Campo* Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. The test is free.
