## Wharton County, TX Tuesday, August 24, 2021 0900 hours

For the period of August 16 – August 22, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred seventy-one (171)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area "Q") is currently at **24.19%**. The number of active COVID-19 cases in our county is now at **two hundred twenty-nine (229)**. We cannot stress enough the importance of using all available tools to curb the infection rate: Wear the mask when unable to socially distance or asked, maintain a safe distance, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer frequently, and for those still unvaccinated and do not have medical reasons why they cannot – get the vaccine.
