Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **seventy-two (72)** new positive cases of COVID-19, **seventy-six (76)** recoveries and, sadly, **seven (7)** more fatalities. We are still working on getting more information on deaths due to COVID in our County. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **13.56%**; **this is the second consecutive day less than 15%**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing for next Tuesday, February 16, has been CANCELLED. The next testing is schedule for THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 25 at the Wharton Civic Center, 8am-4pm. The link is https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening or you can text DOCSTX to 41411. The test is free.
