Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred eight (108)** new positive cases of COVID-19, **one hundred thirty-two (132)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **17.09%**.
