Over the past week, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have sixty-three (63) new positive cases of COVID-19, one hundred fifteen (115) recoveries. We have also received a report of eleven (11) fatalities, bringing our confirmed total to eighty-nine (89). Our regional hospitalization rate is currently 10.71%.

IMPORTANT: COVID-19 Testing is being done TODAY at the El Campo Civic Center, 8am-4pm. The link is https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening or you can text DOCSTX to 41411. The test is free. The next testing date will be next Tuesday, March 9, at the Wharton Civic Center.
