Wharton County, TX Wednesday, September 8, 2021 1200 hours

For the period of August 30 – September 5, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **two hundred three (203)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area "Q") is currently at **23.17%**. The number of active COVID-19 cases in our county is now at **three hundred twenty-four (324)**. We cannot stress enough the importance of using all available tools to curb the infection rate: Wear the mask when unable to socially distance or asked, maintain a safe distance, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer frequently, and for those still unvaccinated and do not have medical reasons why they cannot – get the vaccine.
