Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **sixty-six (66)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **sixty-eight (68)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **6.82%**.

IMPORTANT: COVID-19 testing is being done TODAY, TUESDAY, APRIL 13, at the WHARTON CIVIC CENTER, from 8 am – 4 pm. *COVID-19 Testing will be done again next Tuesday, April 20 at the El Campo Civic Center, 8am–4pm.
