Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **fifty-one (51)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **thirty-six (36)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **5.99%**.
