## Wharton County, TX, Friday, January 22, 2021 1430 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **two hundred fourteen (214)** new positive cases of COVID-19, **two hundred twenty-six (226)** recoveries. After undergoing a coordinated audit of the caselog with DSHS, thirty-eight cases were removed from the log because of transfers to other counties and/or duplications. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **19.31%**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is next Tuesday, January 26, at the Wharton Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required.
