Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred forty-eight (148)** new positive cases of COVID-19, **one hundred thirty-three (133)** recoveries. Sadly, we have also received notification of **three (3)** additional fatalities, bringing our total to 70. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **18.69%**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is next Tuesday, February 2, at the El Campo Civic Center, 8 - 4 pm. Registration is required. The link is https://secure.dentrustocs.com/docs/tdemscreening or you can text DOCSTX to 41411. The test is free.
