Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **seventy-three (73)** new positive cases of COVID-19, **seventy-two (72)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **18.79%**.
