Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **twenty-seven** (27) new positive cases of COVID-19 and **sixty-nine** (69) recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently 3.97%.
