For the period of September 20 – September 26, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred thirty-one (131)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area "Q") is currently at **15.10%**. The number of active COVID-19 cases in our county is now at **one hundred forty-five (145)**. We continue to stress the importance of using all available tools to curb the infection rate: Wear the mask when unable to socially distance or asked, maintain a safe distance, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer frequently, and for those still unvaccinated and do not have medical reasons why they cannot – get the vaccine.

Sadly, we must report that since September 19, **three (3)** more of our residents have succumbed to this disease, bringing our total to **one hundred fifty-seven (157).**
