Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **one hundred ninety-nine (199)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **one hundred eighty-five (185)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **5.44%**.
