## City of Wharton Low Water Pressure Notice

Wharton, TX, February 17, 2021-

At this time, City of Wharton residents are being asked to actively conserve water. The Public Works Department will be making repairs within the water system that are a result of the winter storm event. This could mean that residents experience low water pressure until repairs are completed. Please avoid high usage like washing clothes, running dishwashers, and/or taking extended showers or baths. Also, during daytime hours please discontinue running or dripping faucets to allow the water system to maintain pressure.

This is **NOT** a boil water issue at this time and actively conserving water will prevent any boil water notices from being issued.

The City of Wharton will notify residents when the water system is fully operational and normal water consumption can be resumed.
