Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **eleven (11)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** new recoveries to report. There are **no (0)** probable cases included in these numbers.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **six hundred forty-seven (647)** in Wharton County and we have had **two hundred eighty-five (285)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred fifty-five (355)** active COVID-19 cases. No additional deaths have been recorded today, so our confirmed total remains at **seven (7)**.

IMPORTANT: Testing is scheduled for tomorrow, Tuesday, August 4 & Thursday, August 6, at El Campo Civic Center, 8 AM – 4 PM. NO PRIOR REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED.
