Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **seven (7)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **six (6)** new recoveries to report. There is **one (1)** probable cases included in these numbers, bringing us to a total of **twelve (12)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **six hundred fifty-four (654)** in Wharton County and we have had **two hundred ninety-one (291)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred fifty-six (356)** active COVID-19 cases. No additional deaths have been recorded today, so our confirmed total remains at **seven (7)**.
