Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **eight (8)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **five (5)** new recoveries to report. There is **one (1)** probable case included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **twenty-two (22)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **seven hundred thirty-four (734)** in Wharton County and we have had **three hundred fifty (350)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred seventy-three (373)** active COVID-19 cases. The number of deaths remains at **eleven (11)**.
