For the period of Jun 15-27, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **forty-three (43)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **forty-one (41)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **2.77%**.
