For the period of Jun 1 – Jun 8, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **thirty-three (33)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **thirty-five (35)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **3.07%**.
