For the period of October 18 – October 24, 2021, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received a report from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **forty-six (46)** new positive cases of COVID-19. Our regional hospitalization rate (Trauma Service Area “Q”) is currently at **5.98%**.

Sadly, we report that since October 17 **six (6)** more of our residents have succumbed to this disease, bringing our total to **one hundred eighty-one (181)**.
