Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **sixty-six (66)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **sixty-eight (68)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **6.82%**.
