Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **twenty-seven (27)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **sixty-nine (69)** recoveries. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **3.97%**.
