Wharton County, TX, Thursday, July 30, 2020 1400 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **two (2)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **7 (seven)** new recoveries to report. There is **one (1)** probable case included in these numbers.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **five hundred ninety-seven (597)** in Wharton County and we have had **two hundred sixty-six (266)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **three hundred twenty-four (324)** active COVID-19 cases. No additional deaths have been recorded today, so our confirmed total remains at **seven (7)**.
