For the period of Jun 9-Jun 14, Wharton County Office of Emergency Management received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **fourteen (14)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **twenty-three (23)** recoveries. Sadly, we did receive a report of **one (1)** additional death, making our total **103**. Our regional hospitalization rate is currently **3.32%**.
