Wharton County, TX, Thursday, August 13, 2020 1200 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **eighty-six (86)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **fourteen (14)** recoveries to report. There are **two (2)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **thirty-three (33)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **nine hundred eighty-two (982)** in Wharton County and we have had **three hundred sixty-six (366)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **five hundred ninety-eight (598)** active COVID-19 cases. The total number of deaths remains at **eighteen (18)**.

IMPORTANT: Testing is scheduled for Sunday, August 16, at the El Campo Civic Center, from 8 am-4 pm. No pre-registration is needed.
