Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **twelve (12)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **eight (8)** recoveries to report. There is **one (1)** probable case included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now at **thirty-eight (38)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand sixty (1,060)** in Wharton County and we have had **three hundred ninety-eight (398)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **six hundred forty-four (644)** active COVID-19 cases. The total number of deaths remains at **eighteen (18)**.

IMPORTANT: Testing is scheduled for tomorrow, Tuesday, August 18, at the El Campo Civic Center, from 8 am-4 pm. No pre-registration is needed.
