Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services that we have **nine (9)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **sixteen (16)** new recoveries to report.

The total who have tested positive for COVID-19 is now **one hundred fifteen (115)** in Wharton County and we have had **sixty (60)** reported cases who have recovered and sadly, one death. Wharton County has **fifty-four (54)** active COVID-19 cases.

The recent upward trend in positive cases means we must remain diligent in our social-distancing and hygiene efforts. Now is not the time to let up on our social-distancing practices! Continue to avoid crowds, wear masks when it is recommended or you feel it is in your best interest to do so, and use good common sense when out in the community to avoid spreading disease.
