Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **thirty-eight (38)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **twelve (12)** recoveries to report. There are **four (4)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases is now **thirty-seven (37)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand twenty (1,020)** in Wharton County and we have had **three hundred seventy-eight (378)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **six hundred twenty-four (624)** active COVID-19 cases. The total number of deaths remains at **eighteen (18)**.

IMPORTANT: Testing is scheduled for Sunday, August 16, at the El Campo Civic Center, from 8 am-4 pm. No pre-registration is needed. Additionally, there will be drive-thru testing at the El Campo Civic Center on Tuesday, August 18, same times.
