Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **ten (10)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **no (0)** recoveries to report. There are **no (0)** probable cases included in these numbers, thus the total number of probable cases included in the total number of cases remains at **fifty-five (55)**.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand two hundred fifty-nine (1,259)** in Wharton County and we have had **four hundred fifty-three (453)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **seven hundred seventy-eight (778)** active COVID-19 cases. **No (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19 were reported, thus our total number of deaths remains at **twenty-eight (28)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for tomorrow, Tuesday, September 1 at the El Campo Civic Center. No registration is required.
