Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **fifteen (15)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **forty-five (45)** recoveries to report.

The total positive cases for COVID-19 is now **one thousand three hundred forty-nine (1,349)** in Wharton County and we have had **one thousand two hundred forty-four (1,244)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **sixty-six (66)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for today, Tuesday, September 15 at the El Campo Civic Center, from 8am-4pm. No prior registration is required.
