Wharton County, TX, Thursday, September 17, 2020 1200 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received a report today from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) that we have **thirty-three (33)** new positive cases of COVID-19 and **four (4)** recoveries to report. With 2 more adjustments, our confirmed cases are now **one thousand three hundred seventy-three (1,373)** and we have had **one thousand two hundred fifty-three (1,253)** reported cases who have recovered. Wharton County has **eighty-one (81)** active COVID-19 cases. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **thirty-nine (39)**.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is scheduled for next Tuesday, September 22 at the Wharton City Civic Center, from 8am-4pm. No prior registration is required.
