## Wharton County, TX, Tuesday, October 27, 2020 0930 hours

Wharton County Office of Emergency Management has received reports from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Houston office, that we have **twenty-five (25)** new positive cases of COVID-19, and **five (5)** recoveries. We have been notified of **no (0)** additional fatalities due to COVID-19, thus our total number of deaths remains at **forty-seven (47)**. Our fourteen day total of new confirmed cases is now at **forty-seven (47)**, that does NOT include any probables.

IMPORTANT: County-wide testing is TODAY, October 27, at the City of Wharton Civic Center, 8 am - 4 pm. No prior registration is necessary. This is a free test.
